ABOUT THE CAMP:

The **Autism and Developmental Disorders Lab** (ADDL) at Simon Fraser University is hosting a camp for **youth and adults with intellectual disabilities**! This is a **FREE**, fun, and educational camp with a focus on learning about physical activity. Campers will go through accessible games and activities in a group with up to 8 other campers, and will be supervised by trained volunteers and staff. All campers will receive a free camp T-Shirt! Healthy snacks will also be provided for caregivers and attendees.

The majority of the day will be spent doing fun social games, learning about nutrition, and getting active! A small portion of the camp will be a research activity to discuss your child's thoughts on physical activity through a 1-on-1 conversation with a trained staff member.
